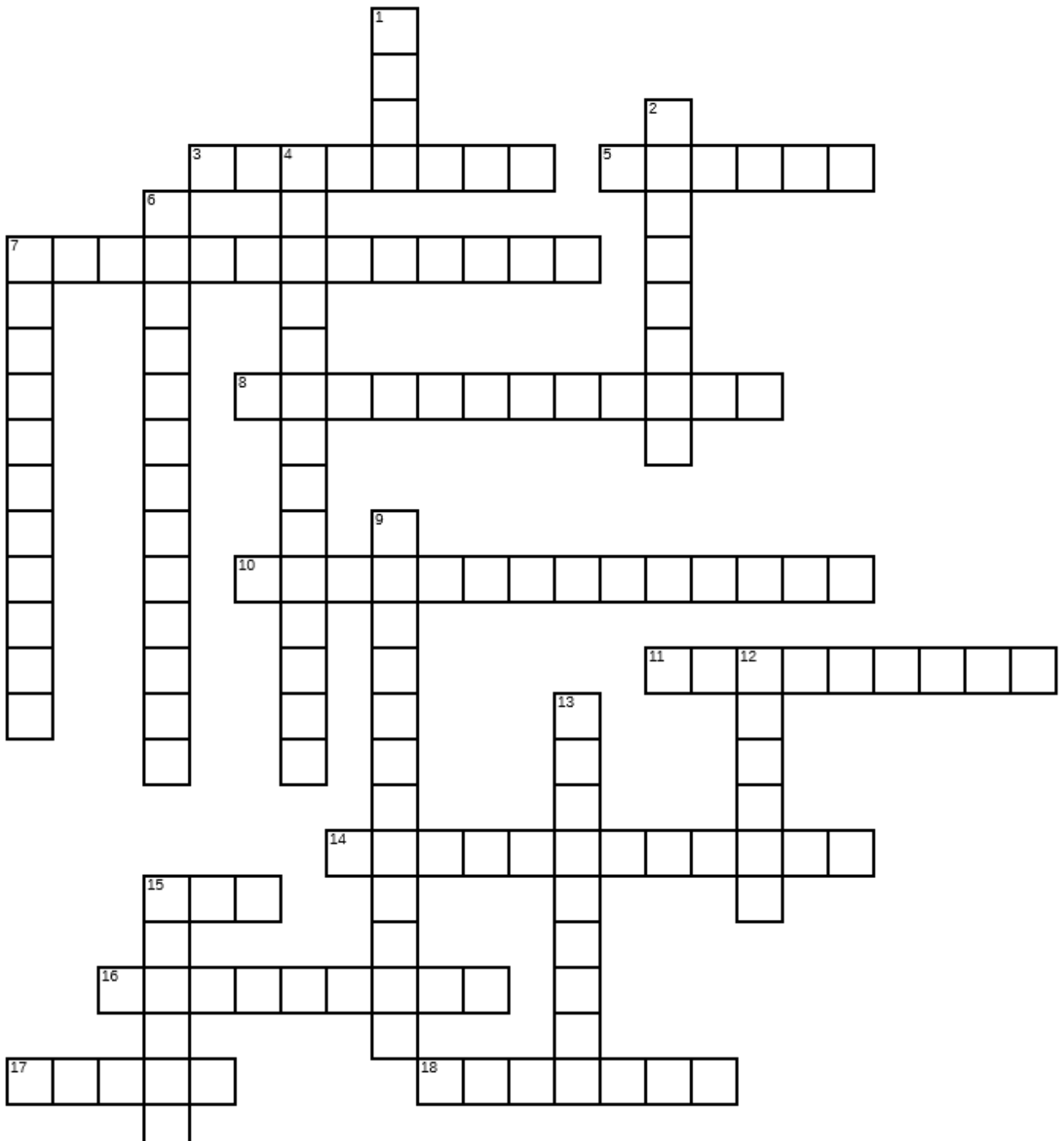




Fellowship Crossword Puzzle – High Holy Days

- 3 Tradition on the first day of Rosh Hashanah during which Jewish people ceremonially cast their sins into a body of water
- 5 The service that marks the end of the Yom Kippur fast, known as “the closing of the gates”
- 7 Also known as Rosh Hashanah
- 8 The holiest time on the Jewish calendar that begins with Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New Year, and ends with Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement
- 10 Another name for Yom Kippur
- 11 The holiest day of the Jewish year
- 14 The three biblical principles of repentance, prayer, and tzedakah (charity) that help the Jewish people prepare for the High Holy Days
- 15 An act of offense against God, which the Jewish people seek atonement for during Yom Kippur
- 16 A traditional cake of Rosh Hashanah in which the sweetness symbolizes the wishes for a good year ahead
- 17 The book of the Bible that is traditionally read at the Yom Kippur service
- 18 The main observance required on Yom Kippur

- 2 The Hebrew word for repentance, which is the main call during the High Holy Days
- 4 The act of cleansing
- 6 What is sounded during the High Holy Days, calling the Jewish people to repentance and restoration

- 9 The Jewish New Year
- 12 The ritual bath associated with Yom Kippur
- 13 In biblical times, the animal that carried the sins of the Israelites and was then cast into the wilderness
- 15 The Jewish trumpet traditionally made from the horns of a ram and central to the High Holy Day observances.
