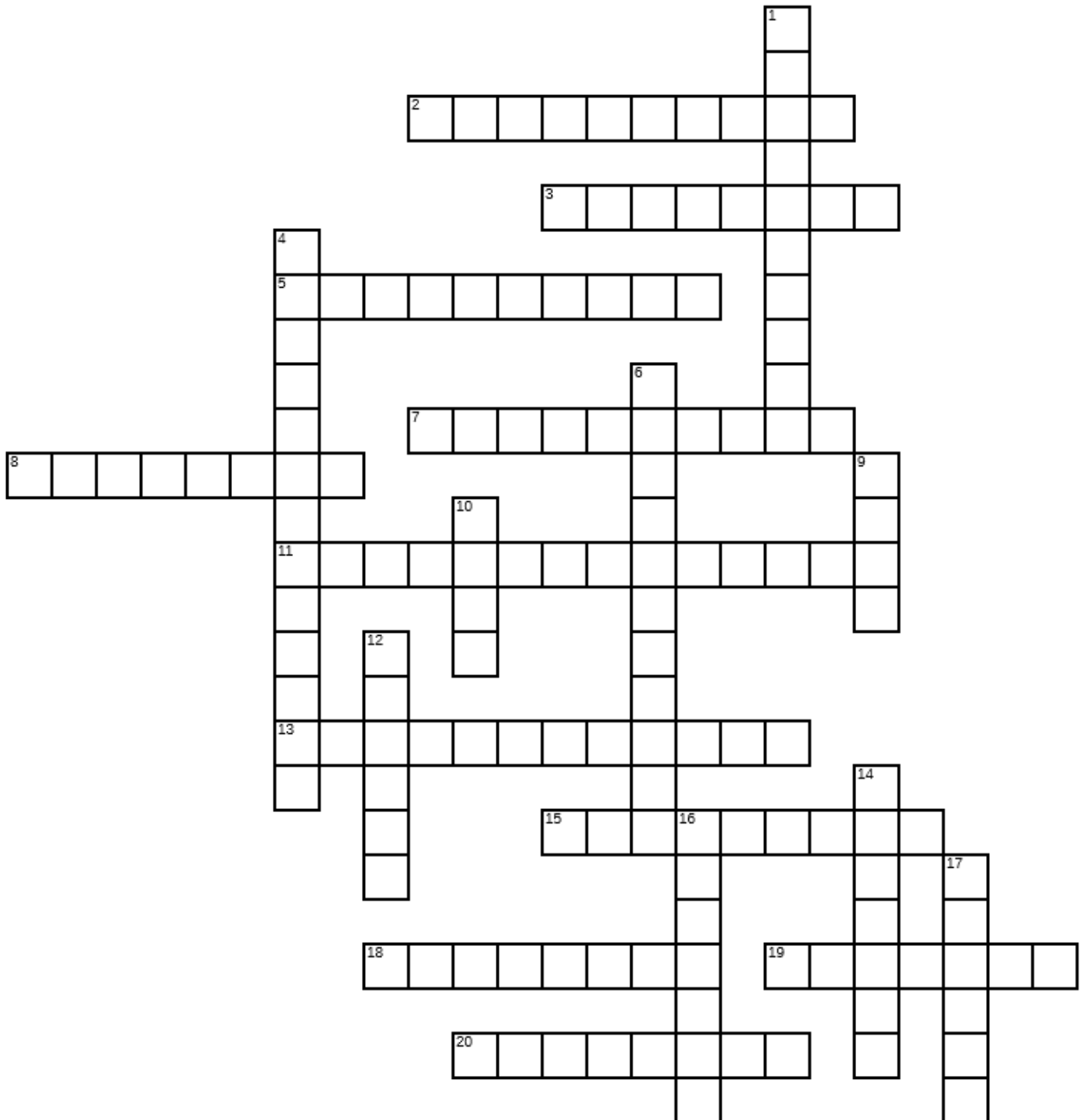




Fellowship Crossword Puzzle – Tisha B'Av
