Sermon Essentials

At its core, the **Together for Israel** event is designed to share God's love toward His precious Jewish people. And to communicate His heart, we're pleased to provide the following materials as you plan and prepare for event.

5 REASONS WHY WE SHOULD BLESS ISRAEL AND THE JEWISH PEOPLE

1. BECAUSE GOD BLESSES WHOEVER **BLESSES ISRAEL**

God chose a man named Abram. "And the LORD said to Abram, Go from your land, from your relatives, and from your father's house, to the land that I will show you. I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed" (Gen. 12:1-3).

2. BECAUSE GOD PROSPERS WHOEVER PRAYS FOR ISRAEL

The word Shalom means "well-being, joy, peace, prosperity and abundance" When we pray for peace in the bone "The Shalom" of Israel, the Bible says that God prospers us Psalm 122:6: "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: 'May those who love you be secure.'"

3. BECAUSE OUR SALVATION COMES FROM THE JEWS

Jesus said: "Salvation comes from the Jews" John 4:22; so thanks to a Jew named Jesus of Nazareth today we can enjoy eternal salvation.

4. BECAUSE BY BLESSING THEM WE **BLESS CHRIST**

Jesus tells us in Matthew 25:40, "Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." Every time we bless a Jewish brother it is as if we bless Jesus himself.

5. BECAUSE WE ARE IN DEBT WITH THEM

Christians must be eternally grateful to the Jewish people for their contribution to the Christian faith. The apostle Paul said in Romans 15:27 that we should bless them with our material goods in gratitude for the spiritual goods that they have left us such as the Bible and its promises "They were pleased to do it, and indeed they owe it to them. For if the Gentiles have shared in the Jews' spiritual blessings, they owe it to the Jews to share with them their material blessings."

SCRIPTURE REFERENCES:

Genesis 12:3 "I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

Isaiah 58:7 "Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter - when you see the naked, to clothe them."

Psalm 102:13 "You will arise and have compassion on Zion, for it is time to show favor to her; the appointed time has come."


