Passover

Providing Security

You helped save Jewish lives by supporting ongoing safety measures and emergency preparedness to Israeli communities, first responders, hospitals, synagogues, and other Jewish institutions.

Security Programs

More than 90,000 people were provided with basic needs such as food, clothing, hygiene materials, and housing

Over 10,000 evacuated families in Israel were provided with food cards for Passover

5,000 food & hygiene kits were prepared for families and elderly in northern Israel

Over 1,000 meals were provided daily through soup kitchens in northern Israel under rocket fire

26 mobile bomb shelters were installed near bus stops in northern Israel

5 armored security vehicles were provided for use by local authorities

600 emergency shelter kits were prepared for citizens living in public bomb shelters in case there is full-out war along Israel's northern border

Bernaldo and Mary, from a small Jewish community deep in the Peruvian Amazon, made aliyah in June. "We are very happy to finally walk on the same land as our ancestors did thousands of years ago." Bernaldo said.

"Besides feeling connected to Israel, we also want to think about what is best for our son," Bernaldo shares. "We want him to grow up with knowledge and pride about his roots and his identity."

When the war broke out on October 7, "We discussed it," Mary says. "We have confidence in Israel and in God, and that this war will end. We understand that responsibilities go along with becoming Israeli citizens. We want to contribute to the country, and we are going to be there, through the easy times and the not-so-easy ones, like now."
